23. Into what estate did the fall bring mankind?

The fall brought mankind into an estate of sin and misery.

24. What is sin?

Sin is any want of conformity unto, or transgression of, any law of God, given as a rule to the reasonable creature.

25. Wherein consisteth the sinfulness of that estate whereinto man fell?
